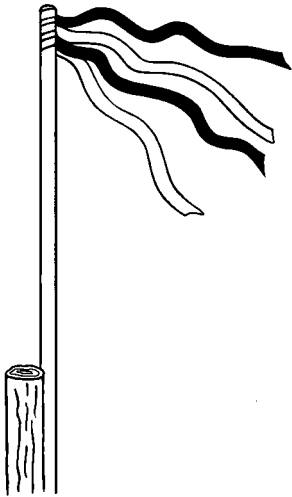

Instructions For Using Bird Deterrent Flash Tape

Flash Tape annoys birds due to its highly reflective mylar surface when exposed to sunlight.

HOW TO USE: Cut 5-6 strips about 30" long. Tape or tie all the strips to poles which are tall enough to extend 3-4' above the crop. Place the poles at 20-25' intervals around and within the crop.



It is very difficult to deter birds once their feeding habit has become established. For best results, place Flash Tape in your crop just before birds are a potential problem (for example, before fruit becomes near-ripe and attractive to birds).

Remove Flash Tape after birds cease to be a problem. Using Flash Tape only when birds are a problem, increases the effectiveness of Flash Tape by delaying habituation. Habituation is the ability of pests to become "used to" and no longer deterred by devices such as Flash Tape which scare birds, but do not cause any actual harm.

We recommend that you use a variety of bird deterrents for maximum effectiveness, and suggest Scare-Eye Balloons (*Item No. TEB*), Netting (*Item No. R40101* and others), and Electronic Bird Scare Devices (*Item No. R33201* and others).

CAUTION: Mylar is an electrical conductor. Contact with electrical wires or equipment may cause harm to the operator. Do not use mylar ribbon near or around power lines., electrical fences, pumps, generators, etc.
