LONG HANDLE

- Serrated Edge On Both Sides of Scuffle Hoe
- Can Be Easily File Sharpened
- Threaded Cross Bar on Tines Snags Roots/Weeds Beneath Surface
- Sturdy Shank and Head Are Riveted to Handle Through a 3 3/4" Steel Ferrule
- Shaped Handle of Varnished Hardwood Ash
- Stands 59" Tall and Weighs 3 Pounds
- 4 Tines Are Each a Full 3/8" Diameter - Strong!
- Threaded Rod 1 1/4" Up from Tine Points Snags Weeds and Fibrous Sod Roots
- Scuffle Hoe Is Cupped to Glide Under The Surface
