TANGLEFOOT® BIRD REPELLENT

R97010 The vast majority of birds are beneficial and a pleasure to observe. However, there are **three nuisance birds** which do vast amounts of property damage and can be an intolerable nuisance. They are also known carriers of disease and insects. These birds are **pigeons, starlings and English sparrows.**

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

TANGLEFOOT® BIRD REPELLENT is a clear, sticky compound used to repel bold pigeons, starlings and English sparrows. The product is non-drying and adheres to all surfaces while retaining its soft, sticky elasticity. This product is registered with the United States Environmental Protection Agency for use against pigeons, starlings and English sparrows.

TANGLEFOOT® BIRD REPELLENT is generally used on natural resting places, such as window sills, the ridge lines of roofs, gutter edges, ornamental coping, ornate stonework cornices and ledges.

COVERAGE

Based on the application of a 1/4" (6 mm) bead, 1 oz. (28 gr) of TANGLEFOOT® BIRD REPELLENT will provide coverage for approximately 1 linear foot (30 cm). Smaller beads will increase the coverage rate.

APPLICATION

1. Apply TANGLEFOOT® BIRD REPELLENT to clean, dry surfaces. Remove dirt, droppings, nests, etc. to assure adhesion. On porous or absorbent surfaces, an undercoating such as paint or other sealer is required. Where prompt removal is anticipated, apply over waterproof tape or similar material.
2. Beginning 1" (2.5 cm) from outside edge, apply a line of 1/4" (6 mm) in width. Use narrower width for smaller species such as English sparrows. **DO NOT APPLY WIDER LINES!** On surfaces up to 4" (10 cm) wide, 1 bead of Bird Repellent should be sufficient.
3. On ledges, apply a line about one inch from the outer edge. Large birds require a bead spacing of 3" (8 cm) on flat surfaces, while small birds require a bead spacing of 2" (5 cm). On extra wide ledges apply several such lines or apply a line in the front and back it with a "S" or "Z" pattern. Peaks, narrow beams or ledges require a single bead only. Leave gaps for rain water. A break of 1" (2.5 cm) should be left in the lines every 3' (91 cm). Do not apply in rainy or damp weather.

REMOVAL AND CLEAN-UP

TANGLEFOOT® BIRD REPELLENT can be removed with cleaning solvents such as mineral spirits.

REPELLER RIBBON

R97025 TANGLE GUARD® REPELLER RIBBON is a space age, holographic diffraction foil that helps drive unwanted birds away by producing an optical, audible and physical discomfort zone. Useful in gardens, home orchards, berry patches, roosting areas and more. The light reflected from its surface is perceived in a ripple pattern that is three dimensional and highly chromatic which represents a menace to pest birds. Wind, even the slightest breeze, will produce a fierce, metallic sounding rattle which is unsettling toward birds. When applied in a line fashion along a ledge or fence, it cuts off access to bird's landing strips. If cut in 24" to 30" lengths and hung from outer limbs of trees, with twine, it is useful in repelling birds in home orchards. Also useful in repelling deer.

BIRD CHASER

TANGLEFOOT® BIRD CHASER will scare away flocks of birds who are repelled by its color and unusual design. The eyes exaggerate the gaping mouth and glaring eyes of a predator bird. Its waving streamers and bobbing and weaving motion simulate a live predator bird which frightens birds immediately. Ideal for use in gardens, home orchards, berry patches, decks, patios, swimming pools, boat docks and more.
